


Langley - ESOL EQUIP Study Programme



Course Information

Your ESOL course will help you develop your speaking & listening, reading and writing skills, which will help you become more confident in your everyday life in the UK. You will study topics including food, sports, education, music and films, travel, health, science, work, numeracy and ICT. We will learn new vocabulary and grammar and revise what you already know. Courses also include employability skills, British Values, Prevent and personal development to prepare you for the next steps in your progression in education, employment or training. We also offer a wide range of other courses you can do in order to boost your programme of study such as Living and Working in the UK and Essential Digital Skills Qualifications. There may be trips arranged during the academic year to enrich your learning experience. It is important that you attend every class activity, as they are all part of your learning journey.

Exams

You will be working towards the Trinity Skills for Life Speaking & Listening, Reading and Writing examinations. Exams are booked in advance and it is very important that you attend them so you can get a certification. It is vital that you do not miss your exams, or you might be asked to pay for re-sit fees.

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Equipment & Books

You will need to buy 2 coursebooks for your lessons, a student's book and a workbook for extra practice. Your teacher will inform you which ones you should buy. If you cannot afford them, the College may be able to help you with that.

Student Finance

You can apply for financial help through our Student Finance Department.

You may receive financial support for travel, course materials, free college meals and childcare support.

We also offer wellbeing support to any students struggling during the financial application process.

Homework

To help you improve your English, you will be given homework every week. You must complete your homework regularly and on time. .

In addition, you will be set targets which will be aimed at any areas you need to improve on.

It is very important that you come to class. You must attend at least 95% of all lessons and arrive on time. **You must not book any holidays during term time.**
