Course PPE Requirements

PPE is not supplied by Slough & Langley College. Students will be required to purchase the following:

Mandatory: *You can purchase basic requirements from Screwfix or Toolstation*

- Boots
- Overalls

Additional items you can purchase:

- Personal goggles
- Gloves
- Ear defenders



Stationery requirements

Students will be required to purchase the following:

- A4 lever arch file, for notes, handouts, revision papers and mock test papers.
- A4 notepad
- Pens
- Pencils
- Rulers.

All Level 2 (IMI) students will be required to purchase a coursebook called Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Level 2 as key elements of the course will be delivered using this book. This book will be available to purchase via PayMyStudent at a discounted rate. Cost: £31.00

All Level 3 (IMI) students will be required to purchase a coursebook called Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Level 3 as key elements of the course will be delivered using this book. This book will be available to purchase via PayMyStudent at a discounted rate. Cost: £34.00



Industry Placement

As part of your Level 2 and Level 3 Motor Vehicle study programme you are required to carry out industry placement. This can be completed in a vehicle service and repair workshop, parts supplier or rapid fit centre. The dates are listed below but subject to change depending on industry requirements.

During your induction you will have 2 weeks to find 5 industry placements in readiness to choose one to host your work experience. All employers accepting industry placement students, will be visited to ensure that they comply with health and safety regulations, have the correct insurance and are familiar with the aims of the Industry Placement programme.
